12 month (1.0 FTE) = \$82,500

The Homeless Service Training Instructor will develop training programs, provide ongoing direct professional development and the training of district and identified school building liaisons in the Tri-county region. This position shall provide direct staff development service for schools and agency collaboration and intervention.

Time spent on this program will be 100%. Service distribution shall be - 90% on training and 10% on program management.

The position is budgeted for 12 months/4weeks vacation. At a minimum, this position requires a Masters Degree with an emphasis in Social Work, Educational Psychology, other related field and knowledge of school and agency service coordination.

Homeless Training Assistant (200-100)

12 month (1.0 FTE) = \$53,500

The Homeless Training Assistant will dedicate 100% of service time to this project and provide assistance in recruitment and training of liaisons. Development of PowerPoint training programs and technical word processing needs will be a responsibility of this position. Training presentations will be presented in cooperation with the Training Instructor. The training coordination of direct homeless youth school building service liaisons shall be provided through this position. The position is for a period of 12 months/4 weeks vacation. Service distribution shall be 90% on training and 10% on project management. Work experience in training program development and technical word processing skills required.
