

**RESOLUTION AGREEMENT**  
**Brick Township Public Schools**  
**Case No. 02-11-1200**

In order to resolve the compliance concerns identified in Case No. 02-11-1200, Brick Township Public Schools (the District) assures the U.S. Department of Education, New York Office for Civil Rights (OCR), that it will take the actions detailed below pursuant to the requirements of Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (Section 504), as amended, 29 U.S.C. § 794, and its implementing regulation at 34 C.F.R. Part 104, and Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (the ADA), 42 U.S.C. § 12131 et seq., and its implementing regulation at 28 C.F.R. Part 35.

**Action Item 1:**

By December 31, 2011, the District will add appropriate signage to the exterior accessible route from the parking lot to and at the designated accessible entrance at the Lake Riviera Middle School (the School), and ensure that the surface of the curb cut on the accessible route is even, consistent with the Uniform Federal Accessibility Standards (UFAS), Americans with Disabilities Act Accessibility Guidelines (ADAAG), or equivalent standards.

**Reporting Requirement:** By December 31, 2011, the District will provide OCR with documentation (e.g., copies of paid invoices, photographs) confirming completion of all alterations to the School's exterior accessible route and designated accessible entrance.

**Action Item 2:**

By October 31, 2011, the District will develop a plan to ensure that the designated accessible entrance to the School offers access comparable to that which is provided at the School's main entrance; e.g., ensure that if the accessible entrance is locked, the mobility impaired can alert staff through a buzzer or similar means of the need to gain entry.

**Reporting Requirement:** By October 31, 2011, the District will provide OCR with its plan for ensuring that the mobility impaired have access at the designated accessible entrance comparable to that which is provided at the School's main entrance. If the plan includes the addition of a buzzer or other means of alert, the District will provide OCR with documentation (e.g., copies of paid invoices, photographs) confirming completion of these alterations to the School's designated accessible entrance.

**Action Item 3:**

By November 30, 2011, the District will develop and publish a policy and/or procedure for ensuring that designated accessible parking spaces at the School are used only by individuals with handicapped parking permits.

**Reporting Requirements:** By November 30, 2011, the District will provide OCR with a copy of the policy and/or procedure developed in accordance with Action Item 3; and

with copies of documentation demonstrating that it published the policy and/or procedure on its website and at the School.

The District understands that OCR will not close the monitoring of this agreement until OCR determines that the District has fulfilled the terms of this agreement and is in compliance with the regulations implementing Section 504, at 34 C.F.R. § 104.21, and the ADA, at 28 C.F.R. §§ 35.149, which were at issue in this case. The District also understands that by signing this agreement, it agrees to provide data and other information in a timely manner in accordance with the reporting requirements of this agreement. Further, the District understands that during the monitoring of this agreement, if necessary, OCR may visit the District, interview staff and students, and request such additional reports or data as are necessary for OCR to determine whether the District has fulfilled the terms of this agreement and is in compliance with the regulation implementing Section 504, at 34 C.F.R. § 104.21, and the ADA, at 28 C.F.R. §§ 35.149, which were at issue in this case.
