

DESIGNATED ACCESSIBLE PARKING SPACES

The Brick Township Board of Education will designate accessible parking spaces within parking lots at district schools, office buildings and other school facilities where employees and visitors have on-site parking. The location and number of designated accessible parking spaces will be determined in accordance with applicable Federal and State law and applicable local ordinances and codes.

These designated accessible parking spaces shall only be used by individuals with handicapped parking permits. A vehicle shall not be parked in one of these designated parking spaces unless there is a handicapped parking permit within plain view from outside the vehicle. In the event there is a vehicle parked in a designated accessible parking space without a handicapped parking permit the Principal or designee will make an announcement on the school's public address system to have the vehicle relocated to another parking space in the parking area. If the car is not moved within five (5) minutes of the announcement, the Principal or designee shall contact the Brick Township Police Department to enforce the applicable laws and codes regarding a vehicle parked in a designated accessible parking space without a required handicapped parking permit.

In the event a staff member had a temporary disability requiring the temporary use of a designated accessible parking space, the Principal, upon consultation with the school nurse, may issue a temporary handicapped parking permit for the staff member.

In order to ensure designated accessible parking spaces are occupied by vehicles with a clearly displayed handicapped parking permit, the Principal or a staff member designated by the Principal will inspect the vehicles in these designated accessible parking spaces periodically during the school day.
