

PURPOSE FOR WHICH GRANT FUNDS WILL BE USED (overview, please include fiscal year):	This pilot is being offered and funded through a partnership with the New Jersey Department of Education, the Overdeck Family Foundation and the Foundation for Educational Administration. The purpose of the pilot is to engage school districts that are committed to utilizing the newly released NJDOE Instructional Units in Algebra 1 within the <u>Connected Action Roadmap (CAR)</u> process. This pilot is intended to build the capacity of educators in New Jersey schools to work effectively in professional learning communities (PLCs) using the newly released NJDOE Instructional Units. The overarching intent of the pilot is to assist districts in ensuring

	<p>that every student has access to a viable standards-based curriculum.</p> <p>Districts will be provided with the following supports:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Regional pilot cohort sessions (2) per year ● In-district coaching sessions (number of sessions varies based on the size of the district) ● School-based PLC teams will receive in-district professional learning on the CAR Framework, the CAR conversations and formative assessment over a three year period. (number of sessions varies based on the size of the district) ● An online platform for networking with other pilot districts ● To ensure sustainability educators, selected as district-based coaches, will receive training in years 2 and 3. <p>The first year of the pilot will run from November 2019 - August 2020. Funding for years 2 and 3 has yet to be determined, but all three organizations supporting the grant are committed to securing funding sources for years 2 and 3.</p>
