5. Jump, Perry and Company, L.L.P. acknowledges and agrees that the Board may modify, amend, suspend and/or terminate the procurement process (in its sole judgment). In any case, the Board shall not have any liability to the Respondent for any costs incurred by the Respondent with respect to the procurement activities described in this RFP.

6. Jump, Perry and Company, L.L.P. acknowledges that the provision of Auditing services must comply with all applicable affirmative action and similar laws. Respondent hereby agrees to take such actions as are required in order to comply with such applicable laws.

9. Jump, Perry and Company, L.L.P. agrees to defend, indemnify and hold the Brick Township Board of Education harmless with respect to any claim for injury to person or property arising out of acts of Jump, Perry and Company, L.L.P., its subsidiaries, parents, agents, principals or employees.

10. Jump, Perry and Company, L.L.P. agrees that the services may be terminated by the Board by giving Jump, Perry and Company, L.L.P. 30 days advance written notice.
