

PARTICIPATION OF HOME-SCHOOLED STUDENTS IN INTERSCHOLASTIC ATHLETICS

The Board of Education believes that home-schooled students who are of high school age should be allowed to compete in interscholastic athletics provided both the school and the home-schooled student comply with NJSIAA guidelines. These guidelines are designed to ensure that homeschoolers who participate in sports meet the same eligibility requirements as other student-athletes. Eligibility will be determined by the building principal according to Regulation 5135.
